

Rush Tickets

\$10 the day of the performance (or the Friday before weekend events) at the Michigan League Box Office

\$15 at the door the night of the performance wherever the event is being held!

Rush Ticket availability and seating are subject to Ticket Office discretion. Valid college ID required. Limit two tickets per student. Rush tickets may not be available in the case of a sellout.

UMS Student Card




Arts & Eats


